

## **Brief of review from Telekom Idag (Telecom Today) in Sweden in English**

That it is perfectly acceptable to combine advanced features with fairly simple management and good looks show DrayTek with Vigor2130n. Typical consumer features such as iTunes server and bit torrent client facing opportunities to both fix the VPN connection to headquarters, sharing the network in separate VLAN and build a separate wireless guest network.

Vigor2130n is already fit to do IPv6, so there is no obstacle to move on with the transition. Vigor2130 family is available with or without WiFi and also a version with built-in VoIP for up to 6 SIP accounts.

The whole makes Vigor2130n an attractive choice for small offices with high accessibility requirements

## **Conclusion**

Thanks to really good compromise between price and performance the overall victory goes to DrayTek. For a small company or a local branch office the Vigor 2130n is enough. Two VPN tunnels cover the need for smaller offices. At the same time the router can also act as a simple file and print server. The fact that the model is already IPv6 ready has to be seen as a major plus when you take into account the pending shortage of IP-addresses.
